Today we celebrate the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity. This celebration of the Holy Trinity is unique in that we are not celebrating Jesus, Mary, the Holy Spirit, or a specific Saint, but we are celebrating a sacred Doctrine of the Church. Every time we begin prayer, we declare this belief as we sign ourselves with the declaration of the Holy Trinity. The Gospel for this weekend has a group of disciples gathered with Jesus as he commissions them to continue with his ministry here on earth instructing them to make more disciples by baptizing them in “the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit” – the Trinitarian formula the Church has used for centuries.

Our Diocese has begun a one-year celebration of our 75th Anniversary with the theme for the year being: “Pride in the Past, Faith in the Future”. The Youngstown Diocese was established on May 15, 1943 with the Most Reverend James McFadden as our first Bishop. There will be various events and prayer services throughout the year. On February 05, 2019 we will be hosting a presentation on the history of the Diocese. There will also be a display of artifacts and pictures from our Diocesan past. This will be the only presentation in Trumbull County. So mark your calendars now!
